

Dear Parent or Carer,

We thank you for all your continued support during this incredibly difficult time. We have had many questions regarding access to work whilst self-isolating and I'd like to outline our intentions.

1. We are re-sending See-Saw invites to instruct parents on how to download See-Saw Parent App onto Phones and iPads. These will come home today and tomorrow.
2. On Friday we will send home blank exercise books for pupils to work in should they need to self-isolate or in the event of school closures.
3. On Friday we will send home a small pack of work for each pupil as a starting point to home learning.
4. All exercise books will contain the login details for our school accessed websites which include - Mathematics, TT Rockstars, Reading Renaissance, spag.com and Purple Mash
5. We will also send home a list of websites which are offering free access to online learning
6. For children and families already in self-isolation books and work packs can be collected from 3pm on Friday 20th March at the front office. If this not achievable we will arrange for books and work to be sent out. Please contact the school office if this applies to you.
7. In the event of school closure Teachers will send out more work via See-Saw. They will do this once per week and send out a weeks' worth of materials and resources. This will be repeated for as long as is needed.
8. In the event of school closure we will also send home further reading material.

Obviously, this is new to all of us so please bear with us, we will ensure everyone has access to the materials needed should schools need to close.

If you would like to plan any activities yourself all medium and long-term plans are available on the school website.

Our aim here is to keep Shevington Vale open for as long as possible to ensure our community can function during this difficult period. Please ignore rumors and social media postings. Any information on closures will come direct via ParentMail and will only be sent by myself or Mrs. Tomlinson. We are following all advice at Local and National level and will continue to update you daily.
